General Services Administration Federal Supply Schedule

This acquisition is conducted under the authority of Section 201 of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949 (40 U.S.C.501) Multiple Award Schedule Program FAR 8.401 and is justified by the following facts and rationale required under FAR 8.405-6 (a) 2, application of brand name as follows:

- (1) Agency and Contracting Activity

The Defense Commissary Agency (DeCA), Store Services Support Division, Information Technology Branch, proposes to enter into a contract on the basis of other than full and open competition.

- (2) Nature and/or description of the action being approved.

DeCA has a requirement on a limited source basis to procure renewal Maintenance Support for its Oracle software licenses and allow for growth by procuring additional Brand Name Licenses for the application processors increasing them by 25% of the initial base year quantities in the out-years. The period of performance is a base year with two (2) 12 month option years.

This requirement will be solicited as a competitive action utilizing the Army CHESS Smartbuy Program

- (3) Description of Supplies/Services:

These Commercial off-the-shelf software licenses are used to run 90% of the agency's production database instance. This software is used to deploy enterprise applications and maintain security. DeCA's usage includes: secure data with compliance to unique row-level

security, fine-grained auditing, transparent data encryption, and total recall of data on demand. Additional licenses may be required due to changes in operation.

(4) Identification of the justification and the rationale.

10 U.S.C. 2304(c)(1), FAR part 8.405-6, Limited Sources Justification. A brand name item, available on one or more schedule contracts, an item peculiar to one manufacturer which is essential to the Government's requirement.

(5) Determination by the ordering activity Contracting Officer that the anticipated order represents the best value consistent with 8.404(d).

In accordance with FAR 8.404, I hereby determine that the anticipated cost or price to the Government for this delivery order will be fair and reasonable. The Price Reasonableness memorandum detailing the Fair and Reasonable Price Determination will be included in the contract file documentation.

(6) Market Research.

Market research was conducted through the mandatory CHES Enterprise Software Initiative (ESI) site. There is a teaming agreement between CHES and the GSA Administration under their Smartbuy Program which identifies a number of GSA GWACS covered under the CHES program. A BPA under the ESI administered through their Smartbuy program was identified to meet the required specifications. Because of the teaming agreement, agencies are required to solicit and award utilizing the authority of the Multiple Award Schedule Program. In addition to the manufacturer, resellers were identified on the Smartbuy program to meet this requirement.

(7) Any other facts supporting the justification.

Currently DeCA is utilizing Oracle on 15 Production Servers running 34 Oracle Instances, 7 Test Servers running 28 Oracle Instances and 7 Development Servers running 26 Oracle Instances. DeCA has been an Oracle Database Enterprise for the last 14 years. Because database programs are proprietary to their manufacturer's, in an effort to prevent having to replace major portions of its enterprise architecture, the government's only option is to seek innovative practices when moving into the age of Virtualized servers running database software solutions. While seeking those innovations, it is much more cost effective to renew maintenance support and purchase additional licenses as necessary than to have to procure a new application and incur the cost associated with the application's purchase, as well as, the additional cost associated with the implementation of that application.

(8) Contracting Officer's Certification.
