Defense Commissary Agency (DeCA), Store Services Support Division, Information Technology Branch, proposes to enter into a contract on a basis of other than full and open competition.

- (2) Nature and/or description of the action being approved.

DeCA has a requirement on a limited source basis to procure Oracle Software Maintenance at an estimated cost of _____, for a 120 day period of performance. This bridge delivery order also includes a reinstatement fee for the period October 1 through November 14, 2011 at an estimated cost of _____. Additionally, a _____ award fee has been incorporated which may be required, if applicable, to allow for utilizing a pre-existing GWAC.

(3) Description of Supplies/Services:

Bridge Order: W91QUZ-06-A-002 Software Maintenance with a period of performance from November 15, 2011 through March 14, 2012. The requirement is to provide "continuity of maintenance support" for existing site license agreements/subscriptions for Oracle Database Support while DeCA analyzes and evaluates upgrades in Oracle's software. As DeCA's enterprise gravitates toward the Department of Defense's mandate for more virtualization in the enterprise architecture, all current licensing applications must be re-evaluated and/or reconfigured to the new structure required to operate in a Virtual database environment. In many instances this has allowed DeCA to reduce the number of licenses required to run in the virtual environment; however, new licensing requirements cannot be assessed without proper evaluation/testing.

(4) Identification of the justification and the rationale.

In accordance with DFARS 208.74--ENTERPRISE SOFTWARE AGREEMENTS, DOD is required to fulfill commercial software and maintenance support for the software through the Enterprise Software Agreements (ESA) in accordance with DOD's Enterprise Software Initiative (ESI). Additionally, through a teaming agreement between Army Chess (CHESS) and the GSA Administration, a number of GSA GWACS are covered under the "CHESS" program. Because of the teaming agreement, agencies are required to solicit and award utilizing the authority of the Multiple Award Schedule Program in accordance with FAR 8.405-6 limited sources justification and approval. In accordance with FAR 8.405-6 (b) (2), the circumstances restricting competition for this acquisition is the new work is a logical follow-on to an original Federal Supply Schedule. The previous award was competitively solicited and awarded and is necessary to ensure continuity of operations." Therefore, this requirement is being awarded as a firm fixed price contract with a four (4) month period of performance

(5) Determination by the ordering activity Contracting Officer that the anticipated order represents the best value consistent with 8.404(d).

The Contracting Officer determines that the anticipated price(s) will be fair and reasonable based on Oracle's pricing structure. They are working diligently to ensure low level pricing for DeCA

licenses during the evaluation of the Virtualization Project to determine the future state of Oracle databases within DeCA.

The Contracting Officer has determined that issuing the proposed Delivery Order to DLT Solutions in support of DeCA's continued Oracle software Maintenance while evaluating the future Virtualization Project support mission, represents the best value, resulting in the lowest overall cost alternative, considering price and administrative costs, to meet the Government's needs. This order will be placed in accordance with FAR 8.404 – Use of Federal Supply Schedules. General Services Administration has already negotiated fair and reasonable pricing.

(6) Market Research.

Was not conducted as this bridge is being placed with the incumbent schedule holder to ensure continuity of operations. DeCA will seek additional schedule holders under GSA Schedule 70, category 132 12 during the new requirement's preparation phase.

(7) Any other facts supporting the justification.

Currently DeCA is utilizing Oracle on 15 Production Servers running 34 Oracle Instances, 7 Test Servers running 28 Oracle Instances and 7 Development Servers running 26 Oracle Instances.

DeCA has been an Oracle Database Enterprise for the last fourteen years.

Because database programs are proprietary to their manufacturer's, in an effort to prevent having to replace major portions of its enterprise architecture, the government's only option is to seek innovative practices when moving into the age of Virtualized servers running database software solutions.

(8) A statement of actions, if any, the agency may take to remove or overcome any barriers that preclude the agency from meeting the requirements of 8.405-1 and 8.405-2 before any subsequent acquisition for the supplies or services is made.

As stated in paragraph six above, once identified and developed, the new requirement will be competed among know Oracle resellers.

(9) Contracting Officer's Certification.
