

**JUSTIFICATION AND APPROVAL
FOR OTHER THAN FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION**

1. **Contracting Office:** Defense Commissary Agency (DeCA), Resale Contracting Directorate (MPR), 1300 E. Avenue, Fort Lee, Virginia 23801-1800.
2. **Type of Contract Action:** Contract modification action to extend the performance period of contract HDEC02-06-D-0003 with Carytown Seafood. for an additional 3 months from June 30, 2012 to September 30, 2012. The contract type is a requirements contract. Funding is provided by the Resale Stock Fund Activity of the Defense Working Capital Fund (DWCF).
3. **Description of Supplies/Services:** This action will provide for uninterrupted operation of seafood markets at Andrews AFB and Fort Meade, Maryland; Bolling AFB, DC; Fort Belvoir, Quantico MCCDC, Langley AFB, Little Creek NAB, Fort Lee, Norfolk NB and Fort Eustis, Virginia. The estimated total value of the additional three-month extension is \$1,348,361, which along with the first two extensions increases the value of this J&A to \$4,494,537.
4. **Authority Cited:** 10 U.S.C. 2304(c)(1), in accordance with FAR 6.302-1(a)(2)(ii), only one responsible source and no other supplies and services will satisfy Agency requirements.
5. **Reason for Authority Cited:** In addition to the previous extension periods stemming from the Contracting Officer's computer crash and recreation of necessary documents, the Contracting Officer found it necessary to request a Certificate of Competency from the Small Business Administration (SBA) for the otherwise apparently successful offeror. Two extensions to the normal response time for the offer were requested. The first request was granted, which caused the award timelines to slip. The current contract will need to be extended an additional three months to provide SBA with sufficient review/response time, allow the Contracting Officer time to finalize the award documentation, and allow for the contract transition time required by the solicitation. Anticipated award date for the follow-on requirement is not later than September 1, 2012, with an anticipated performance start date of October 1, 2012.

In the absence of a contract extension, the seafood market operations will cease in the stores utilizing this contract, which will result in irrevocable damages to the Agency in the form of lost sales and reduced operating funds. The commissary benefit is a cornerstone of the military quality of life. Therefore, it is essential that DeCA provide fully operational commissary stores, to include the seafood market operations.

Carytown Seafood is successfully performing this contract and, as the incumbent contractor, already has the existing infrastructure in place to continue the necessary seafood operations. Given the average 30 day transitional period necessary for a new contractor to be prepared to begin performance, it is not possible to award this requirement to another contractor during this extension period.




